


## **An Inspiring Location**

## **How to Get Here**

### By car

Harbour Car Park is the closest carpark at the rear of the building which is less than a 5 minute walk. There are also two car parks available on the Barbican which are less than a 10 minute walk. We also have limited on-site parking with only 3 disabled bays available on a first come first served basis.

### By train

Walking from Plymouth Train Station takes around 30 minutes, with a taxi taking 10 minutes. The NMA postcode is PL4 OLF.

### By bus

There are several bus routes that stop at Royal Parade, Exeter Street or on the Barbican. Royal Parade and Exeter Street require a 10 minute walk, however the Barbican and Sutton Street are 5 minutes away. Full route planner here
